SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Ford Motorsports records are arranged in three series and are made up of correspondence, press releases and other textual materials, photographs, proof sheets, and negatives maintained by the Lincoln-Mercury Public Affairs Department documenting Ford Motor Company's involvement in racing and performance testing.

The **Events and Automobiles series**, 1957-1968, covers Ford-Lincoln-Mercury involvement in races, durability runs, and rallies such as the Cape Horn to Fairbanks Durability Run, Comet Durability Run and Comet drag racing, East African Safari Rally, Le Mans race, Indianapolis 500 pace car program, and Mobilgas Economy Run. Ford's entry in many of these events was the Mercury Comet. In addition the series contains information on the road trip, "Aventura Alaska-Brasil," taken by William and Renée Carroll and the Lincoln Continental executive limousine.

The **Drivers series**, 1967, consists of biographical information on race car drivers Don Nicholson and Dan Gurney. Other information on drivers, including photographs, can be found in other parts of the collection.

The **Summary Information** series, 1962-1963, consists of summary information on racing events as well as automobile and engine specifications.
